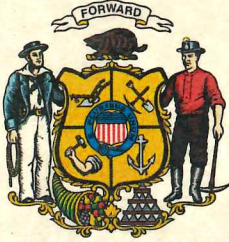

*WHEREAS*; Clean Energy Week is an opportunity to discuss solutions that address Wisconsin's energy needs in the 21<sup>st</sup> century;


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
