Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Energy Transition Act, which became law in 2019, established a statewide renewable energy standard of 50 percent by 2030 for New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the new energy standard is expected to create more than 8,000 new jobs in New Mexico's clean energy economy and stimulate over \$4.6 billion of new investment; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico has wind and solar energy industries that employ more than 5,000 employees and generate nearly 2,600 megawatts; a natural gas industry that produces about 4 percent of the nation's cleaner burning natural gas, and several other significant clean energy industries, including hydropower, geothermal energy, and energy storage; and

WHEREAS, New Mexicans cherish their beautiful natural environment and recognize the imminent threat posed by global climate change; and

WHEREAS, municipalities, organizations and individuals should be encouraged to integrate the cleanest lowest-emitting energy resources possible; the public and private sectors should be supported in further investment, research and development of our state's clean energy resources;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, do hereby proclaim September 23rd–27th, 2019 as:

"National Clean Energy Week"
