Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, Missouri believes in clean, affordable, and readily abundant forms of energy for all; and

WHEREAS, clean energy is a crucial piece of America's energy future; and

WHEREAS, Missouri currently has more than 55,000 clean renewable energy jobs; and

WHEREAS, renewable energy is the third largest employer in Missouri with 5,251 workers; and

WHEREAS, at the end of 2019, Missouri had about 1,000 megawatts of wind power generating capacity from 500 wind turbines, and nearly 900 additional megawatts of wind power under construction.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim September 21-25, 2020, to be

CLEAN ENERGY WEEK

in Missouri.
