

# Proclamation

## by Governor Jim Justice

**Whereas,** clean energy, including generation from renewable sources such as wind, solar, and hydro sources as well as nuclear, natural gas, and energy storage, is part of our country's energy future; and

**Whereas,** more than 5% of the electricity generated in the state in 2018 came from hydropower and wind energy, with wind's share of generation having nearly doubled and surpassed hydropower in 2017; and

**Whereas,** the clean energy sector, including energy efficiency, provided more than 10,000 jobs in the state in 2019.

**Now, Therefore,** Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *September 21-25, 2020* as:

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in this observance.

**In Witness Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
