**WHEREAS, the development of new sources of clean energy, where not in conflict with environmentally sensitive lands and waters, food production, or military training and readiness, can meaningfully contribute to achieving energy independence in Florida and the United States; and**

**WHEREAS, Florida is home to clean energy industry-leading producers of power generation systems, a variety of solar technology companies, biofuel producers, battery and fuel cell manufacturers, expanding natural gas infrastructure and two zero carbon emission nuclear power plants; and**

**WHEREAS, Clean Energy Week in Florida is an opportunity to encourage all individuals and organizations to implement eco-friendly and clean energy practices that reduce air pollution and mitigate other harmful impacts to our environment.**
