- WHEREAS, clean energy employed over 41,000 people in South Carolina in 2020, with the number of clean energy jobs growing 6 percent between 2018 and 2020; and
- WHEREAS, clean energy jobs are inherently local, exempt from outsourcing due to the on-site nature of construction, installation, and maintenance, and contribute to the growth of local communities.
