Whereas,

Austin was ranked by the EPA in 2021 as the city with the sixth highest clean energy usage in the nation with over 300,000,000 kilowatt hours (KWH); and

Whereas,

Texas' clean energy generation potential surpasses the rest of the United States and as a result, has nearly unlimited potential for growth; and

Whereas,

Texas leads the nation in generating power from wind turbines that add to the state's diverse portfolio of renewable energy sources, helping to strengthen our domestic energy supply; and

Whereas,

Austin is home to the University of Texas at Austin which is continually innovating more efficient clean energy practices; and

Whereas,

In celebration of National Clean Energy Week from September 26-30, 2022, all residents are encouraged to find ways to reduce their own carbon footprint in the name of conservation;
