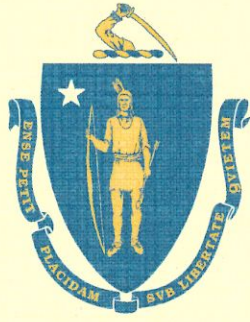


The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Whereas, The Commonwealth requires nearly 60% of electricity served to end-use customers to be sourced from clean and renewable energy resources in 2023 via its Clean Energy Standards and Renewable Energy Portfolio standards; and

Whereas, Massachusetts has over 4,000 MW of operational distributed solar projects; and

Whereas, Massachusetts will soon be the home to the first operational commercial scale offshore wind farm in the United States; and

Whereas, The clean energy sector provided almost 122,000 jobs in the state in 2022,


