

Proclamation

WHEREAS, clean and readily abundant forms of energy are powering more homes and businesses than ever before and are a foundational part of Arizona's future; and
WHEREAS, affordable and reliable clean energy is and will continue to fuel Arizona's robust economy; and
WHEREAS, continued advances in clean energy technologies are critical to our energy future; and
WHEREAS, Clean Energy Week encourages increased organizational and individual support of clean energy solutions to power our economy into the future; and
WHEREAS, the clean energy sector creates quality jobs for Arizonans; and
WHEREAS, Arizona's Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station is the second-largest nuclear power plant in the nation and accounted for 27% of Arizona's total net generation from all sources; and
WHEREAS, in 2023, Arizona ranked among the top five states in the nation in total solar-powered generating capacity, with over 8,400 MW installed.
