Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, across Indiana, clean and readily abundant forms of energy are powering more homes and businesses than ever before; and
- WHEREAS, clean energy is part of America's energy future; and
- WHEREAS, the clean energy sector is a growing part of the economy and has been a key driver of economic growth in Indiana in recent years, with over 81,000 clean energy jobs in the Hoosier State; and
- WHEREAS, Indiana is the sixth-largest ethanol producer in the nation, with its abundance of corn and soybean crops; and
- WHEREAS, renewable resources accounted for about 12% of Indiana's net generation in 2022, mostly from wind resources. By early 2022, Indiana had over 3,450 megawatts of installed wind capacity; and
- WHEREAS, we must harness the power of Indiana entrepreneurs and small businesses to ensure government collaboration to assert American energy leadership and dominance in the global marketplace and assure low-cost reliable energy here at home;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 23-27, 2024 as

Clean Energy Week

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
