## PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, across Indiana, clean and readily abundant forms of energy are

powering more homes and businesses than ever before; and

WHEREAS, clean energy is part of America's energy future; and

WHEREAS, the clean energy sector is a growing part of the economy and has been a key driver of economic growth in Indiana in recent years,

with over 81,000 clean energy jobs in the Hoosier State; and

WHEREAS, Indiana is the sixth-largest ethanol producer in the nation, with

its abundance of corn and soybean crops; and

WHEREAS, renewable resources accounted for about 12% of Indiana's net

generation in 2022, mostly from wind resources. By early 2022, Indiana had over 3,450 megawatts of installed wind capacity;

and

WHEREAS, we must harness the power of Indiana entrepreneurs and small

businesses to ensure government collaboration to assert American energy leadership and dominance in the global marketplace and assure low-cost reliable energy here at home;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 23-27, 2024 as

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
