National Clean Energy
September 23- September 27, 2024

WHEREAS, Across Indiana, clean and abundant forms of energy are powering more homes and businesses than ever before. This includes renewable sources such as wind, solar, hydro, and geothermal, as well as nuclear, natural gas, and carbon capture technologies; and

WHEREAS, leaders, businesses, and individuals across the city are making choices every day to reduce their carbon footprint by identifying opportunities to make significant changes that will save them money while prioritizing greener technology; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, 5,100 megawatts of renewable energy was generated in Indiana, representing 12% of the state's total electricity net generation with wind and biofuels representing two of the largest producers in the state; By early 2022, Indiana had over 3,450 megawatts of installed wind capacity; and

WHEREAS, with over 81,000 clean energy jobs, this industry is a key driver of economic growth in Indiana. Clean energy jobs are inherently local and contribute to the growth of local economies; and

WHEREAS, I encourage all residents of Noblesville to join me in supporting our clean energy industries and resources.
