

Executive Order From the Office of the Mayor

Whereas, The 2019 Energy Transition Act established a statewide renewable energy standard of 50 percent by 2030 for New Mexico; and

Whereas, As of 2023 there were over 12,600 clean energy jobs in New Mexico; and

Whereas, Wind energy accounted for 38 percent of New Mexico's utility-scale electricity net generation in 2023, more than six times the amount in 2015; and

Whereas, New Mexico is among the top 10 natural gas-producing states and has about 7 percent of the nation's proved dry natural gas reserves and in 2023, renewable resources accounted for 55 percent of the total in-state electricity generation; and

Whereas, New Mexicans cherish their beautiful natural environment and recognize the imminent threat posed by global climate change; and

Whereas, Municipalities, organizations, and individuals should be encouraged to integrate the cleanest lowest-emitting energy resources possible; the public and private sectors should be supported in further investment, research and development of our state's clean energy resources; and

Now, Therefore, I, Timothy M. Keller, Mayor of the City of Albuquerque, do hereby proclaim, September 23-27, 2024, as:


