

State of Missouri Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, Missouri believes in clean, affordable, and readily abundant forms of energy for all; and

WHEREAS, clean energy is a crucial piece of America's energy future; and

WHEREAS, Missouri has more than 56,000 clean energy jobs; and

WHEREAS, renewables accounted for nearly 12% of the state's total net generation in 2022, with 70% of renewable generation provided by wind; and

WHEREAS, solar electricity generation in the state has more than tripled since 2014; and

WHEREAS, Missouri has the second-largest biodiesel production capacity in the nation: about 212 million gallons annually at six biodiesel plants.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim September 23-27, 2024, to be

CLEAN ENERGY WEEK

in Missouri.
