Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Energy Transition Act, which became law in 2019, established a statewide renewable energy standard of 50% by 2030 for New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, as of 2024 there were over 13,255 clean energy jobs in New Mexico and the state has experienced the highest job growth rate in the United States for multiple energy transition sectors; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, wind energy accounted for 38% of New Mexico's utility-scale electricity net generation, more than six times the amount in 2015; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, New Mexico ranked 2nd in total oil production and 3rd in total gas production in the United States while maintaining the highest environmental standards and emission regulations in the industry; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, renewable resources accounted for 55% of the total in-state electricity generation; and

WHEREAS, New Mexicans cherish their beautiful natural environment and recognize the imminent threat posed by global climate change; and

WHEREAS, municipalities, organizations, and individuals should be encouraged to utilize the cleanest, lowest-emission energy resources possible; and

WHEREAS, the public and private sectors should be supported in further investment, research and development of our state's clean energy resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, do hereby proclaim September 15th – 19th, 2025 as:

“National Clean Energy Week”

throughout the State of New Mexico.

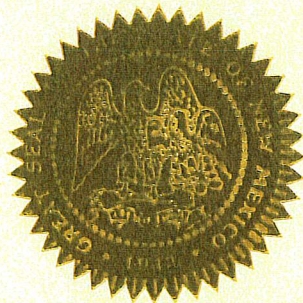
