



WHEREAS, across Colorado, clean and readily abundant forms of energy are powering more homes and businesses than ever before; and

WHEREAS, clean energy is part of America's energy future; and

WHEREAS, the clean energy sector is a growing part of the economy and has been a key driver of economic growth in Colorado in recent years, with over 68,814 clean energy jobs in Colorado; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, renewable sources of energy accounted for 39% of Colorado's total in-state electricity net generation. Wind power accounted for the largest share of Colorado's renewable electricity generation at 70%, followed by combined utility-scale (1-megawatt or larger) photovoltaic and small-scale (less than 1 megawatt) solar at 23%; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, Colorado's Governor 2024 approved \$7.7 million in grant money to support private geothermal development;

THEREFORE, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby proclaim the period of time between September 15 and September 19, 2025, as
