From the Governor of the State of Maryland

NATIONAL CLEAN ENERGY WEEK SEPTEMBER 15-19, 2025

WHEREAS, Clean energy—including solar, hydro, nuclear, wind, and geothermal—is part of our state and our country's energy future;

WHEREAS, The state of Maryland supports affordable, reliable, and clean energy as the foundation on which a strong economy is built; and

WHEREAS, The state is a national leader in clean energy, with numerous programs and efforts to encourage the development of renewable energy across the state; and

WHEREAS, In 2024, clean energy produced over half of Maryland's net electricity generation; and

WHEREAS, In 2022, the Maryland General Assembly enacted a law to reduce the state's greenhouse gas emissions by 60% from 2006 levels by 2031, as well as reach net-zero emissions by 2045; and

WHEREAS, The state supports the development of a strong in-state clean energy sector, which provides over 80,000 jobs to Marylanders, to further diversify our economy; and

WHEREAS, We must harness the power of entrepreneurs and small businesses in Maryland, along with government collaboration, to assert energy leadership in the global marketplace and assure low-cost, reliable energy here at home; and

WHEREAS, As America celebrates National Clean Energy Week, I encourage all individuals and organizations in Maryland to support commonsense solutions that address the nation's economy and energy needs in the 21st century.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim SEPTEMBER 15-19, 2025 as NATIONAL CLEAN ENERGY WEEK in Maryland, and do commend this observation to all of our citizens.
