Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Energy efficiency and clean energy are providing affordability, reliability, and resiliency to Minnesota’s energy system; and
- WHEREAS: Across Minnesota, carbon-free and readily abundant energy sources are already providing over 50% of the state’s electricity to homes and businesses; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota’s clean energy sector employs over 62,000 clean energy workers; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Energy Alley initiative and emerging clean technologies are putting Minnesota at the forefront of burgeoning industries with rapidly growing global demand; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota’s investments in transmission are providing pathways to achieving our nation-leading carbon-free by 2040 electricity standard; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota continues to advance low-carbon biofuel technologies, clean hydrogen, and is leading in sustainable aviation fuel, charting a course to global leadership in decarbonizing air travel; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota ranks eighth in the nation in total generation from wind energy, representing more than 3% of the U.S. total.
