PROCLAMATION IN RECOGNITION OF NATIONAL CLEAN ENERGY WEEK

Whereas, the State of Delaware is committed to promoting clean, affordable, and readily abundant forms of energy for all residents; and

Whereas, clean energy industries provide employment for more than 12,667 Delawareans, contributing to the state's economic vitality and environmental stewardship; and

Whereas, Delaware's Renewable Portfolio Standard mandates that 40% of electricity retail sales be generated from renewable energy sources by 2035, with at least 10% derived from solar energy, demonstrating the state's leadership in sustainable energy policy; and

Whereas, solar energy and biomass are the primary renewable energy sources for electricity generation in Delaware, accounting for approximately 6% of the state's total in-state net generation in 2022, including 4% from solar energy alone; and

Whereas, Delaware households are increasingly embracing cleaner energy for home heating, with 42% using natural gas and 38% relying on electricity as of 2022; and

Whereas, Clean Energy Week serves as an opportunity to highlight the importance of renewable energy, energy efficiency, and innovative technologies that reduce emissions and strengthen our energy independence.
